The experience enhanced the cadets' communication skills, cultural awareness, and sense of national unity.

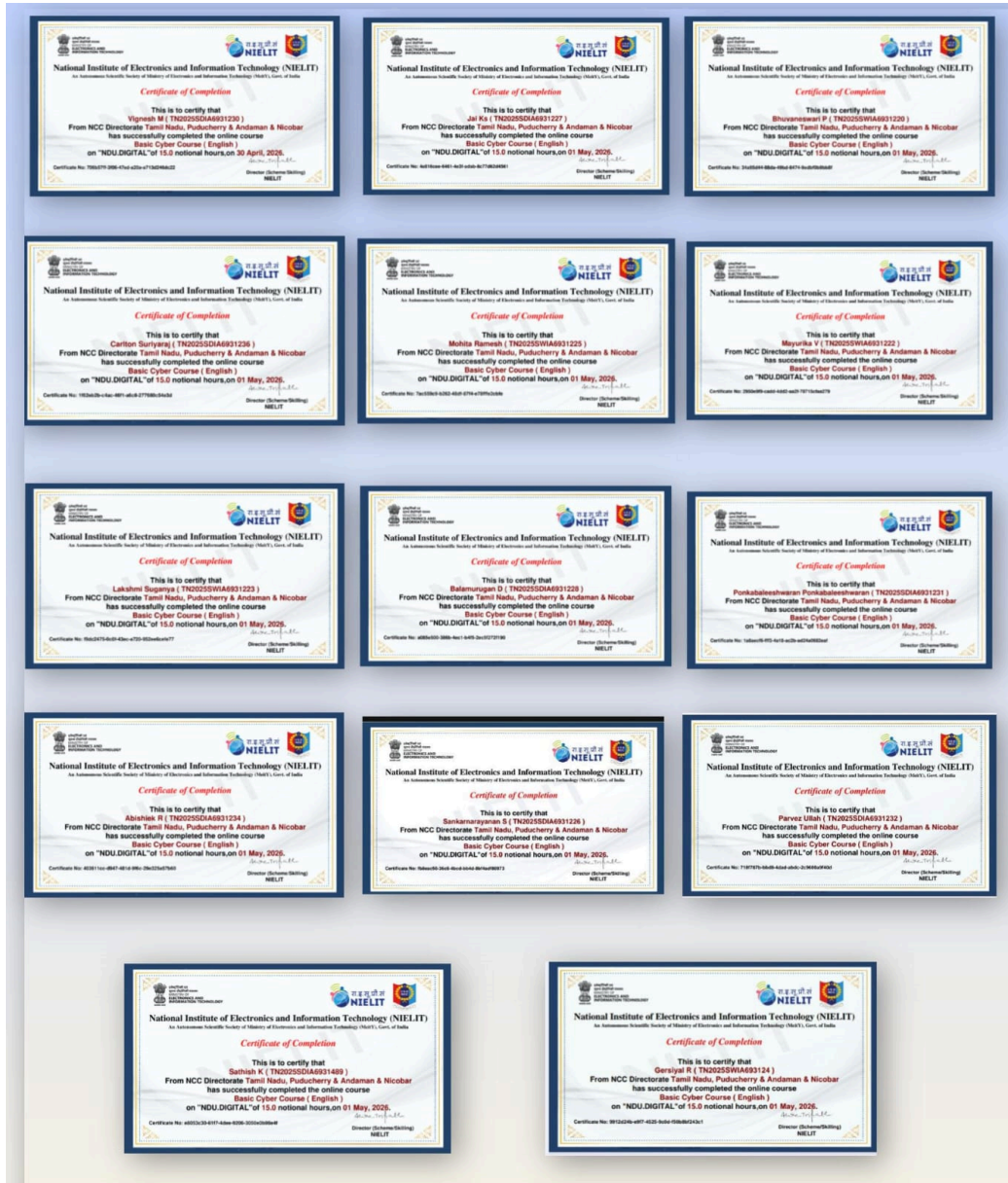
### **Cyber Training Course**
